

Minnesota Laws & Rules Related to Automotive Mercury Switches:

Minnesota requires removal of automotive mercury switches before a vehicle is crushed. Minn. Stat. § 116.92, Subd. 4. **Removal from service; products containing mercury.**

(c) A person may not crush a motor vehicle unless the person has first made a good faith effort to remove all of the mercury switches in the motor vehicle. (Effective August 1, 1995)

Storage and transportation of automotive mercury switches in Minnesota are governed by the state and federal Universal Waste Rules and DOT Haz Mat Rules.
